LETTER FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR/PRESIDENT

“EDUCATION IS THE DOOR TO OPPORTUNITY” has become the unofficial tag line summarizing our mission at the Bishop Walker School. In the context of the many challenges facing African American boys and young men amplified in the news media over the past year, it is clear that our work is more vital than ever.

Increasingly, research confirms that family income is a strong predictor of a child’s success in school. By every measure, from reading and math proficiency to school suspension and high school completion, boys living in underserved communities east of the Anacostia River in Washington, DC lag behind their peers from more affluent communities. We believe that a child’s zip code shouldn’t determine their future prospects.

The trouble with research and the resultant statistics is that the numbers often paint a generic portrait of children that reduces their complex lives to their least common denominator, and create labels that exclude the richness of a student’s history, heritage and resourcefulness.

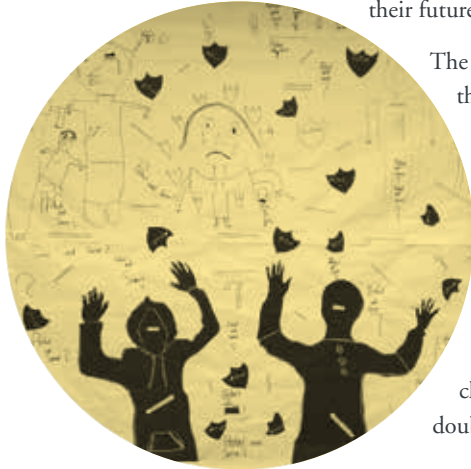
At Bishop Walker School we’re privileged to have the opportunity to develop meaningful personal relationships with our students, enabling us to get to know their individual and unique stories. Getting to know a child’s gifts, talents and aspirations along with their fears, doubts and struggles, empowers us to rid ourselves of the

attitudes, misconceptions and stereotypes that can so easily undermine effective teaching and learning.

When we talk about education at the Bishop Walker School, we’re not just referring to academics. If our boys are going to be successful, in addition to being academically capable, we’ve got to help them navigate a world that will expect them to be socially adept, culturally competent, emotionally mature and spiritually grounded.

Every single day, our talented faculty and staff commit themselves to accompanying our students and their families on an educational journey that is sometimes fraught with detours and temporary roadblocks. In the process of helping our students develop a confident sense of self, often despite the less than flattering images of themselves and their community to which they are regularly exposed, we are all being transformed – often in ways that are humbling, but always in ways that affirm the significance of the work we have undertaken together.

Thank you for joining with us to give boys in our community an opportunity to change the arc of their futures through the gift of a quality education. Your investments of time and resources are what make our life-changing vision possible. GREETINGS FROM THE BOYS AT WASHINGTON VIEW! Our Upper Primary School (3-5) and Middle School (6) is an upbeat, fast paced, and welcoming setting for 40 percent of our Bishop Walker School students.

Our new sixth grade class marks the beginning of the Middle School program. As our students mature, our program grows, too, matching their increasingly sophisticated educational needs. We adopted a departmentalized faculty structure for fifth and sixth grades. Faculty teach subject specific courses to nurture the students' more mature academic ability. The new structure gives our students the opportunity to change classes and build transition management and organizational skills. Departmentalized faculty are particularly passionate about their subject, allowing our students to emulate that enthusiasm and really hone in on an area of study. We've realized this goal for our fifth and sixth grade students by having one teacher focus on Humanities (language arts, grammar, and social studies) and another on Math/Science. The science curriculum now includes a lab component with hands on experiments while math emphasizes competence with technology. In addition, we are integrating technology in all subject areas with a specific emphasis on applications in Math/Science. Our Language department expanded from courses in contemporary Spanish to include an introductory course in the classics to expose our students to Latin and Greek culture, mythology and architecture prior to more specific Latin language study in

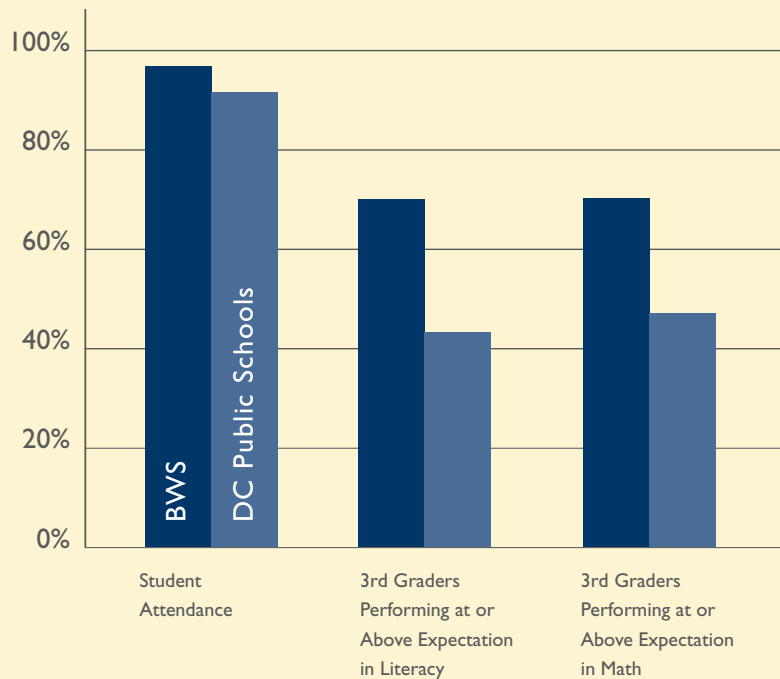
seventh and eighth grades. We are adding special interest clubs, such as journalism and robotics, which provide opportunities for more complex social experiences around a common interest and a student council to build leadership skills.

As the Middle School grows, we will increase academic rigor to challenge the students in an age appropriate way with a globally focused curriculum and exposure to foreign language and world cultures. I look forward to a dedicated science teacher, further departmentalizing faculty, and expanding service learning opportunities. A more formalized interscholastic athletic program would help students develop their competitive spirit. Exploring opportunities to partner with neighboring independent schools on athletics, service projects, and professional development for teachers is anticipated. Even more meaningful field trips will increase the social and academic growth of the boys.

PROGRAM SUCCESSES

In JK through 3rd grade, 84% of students performed at or above expectation in literacy and 79% were at or above expectation in math. 71% of our fourth graders attained the next reading level and 83% of our fifth graders reached the next level in math.

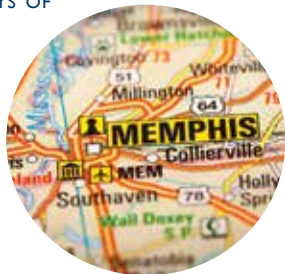


The BWS chorus celebrated MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. DAY at the Washington National Cathedral by performing for hundreds attending the annual program.



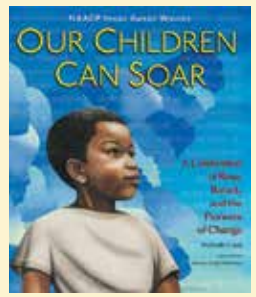
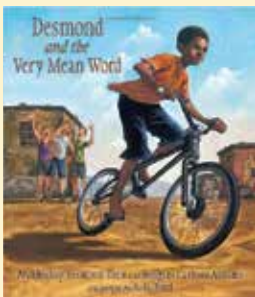
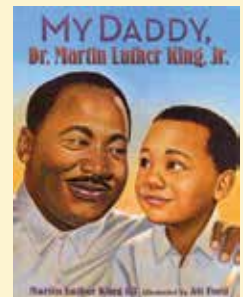
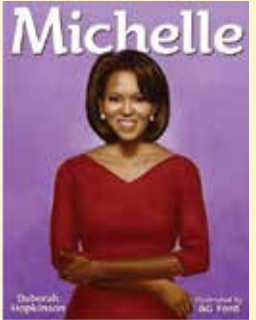
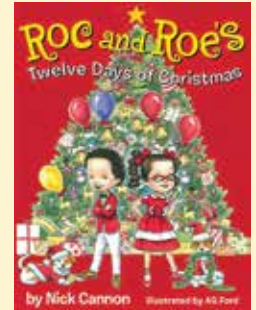
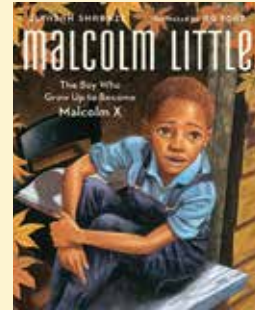

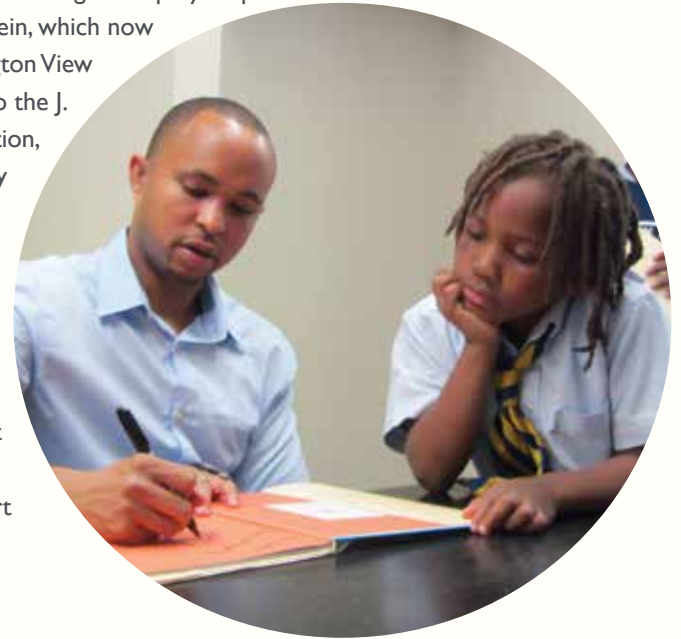
A. G. FORD VISITS

Our second through fifth graders were thrilled to welcome acclaimed illustrator, A. G. Ford to our Washington View campus. Mr. Ford discussed his illustrations in *Desmond and the Very Mean World* co-authored by Archbishop Desmond Tutu and Douglas Carlton Abrams. Mr. Ford is a New York Times Bestselling Children's book Illustrator and recipient of two NAACP Image Awards. Ford attended The Columbus College of Art and Design majoring in illustration. He is now a freelance illustrator, mainly for children's books, and has illustrated picture books for Kareem Abdul-Jabbar, Sharon Robinson, Ilyasah Shabazz, Jonah Winter, Martin Luther King III, Nick Cannon, The Archbishop Desmond Tutu and many others.

Mr. Ford spoke to our students about his love of art and the process he uses to tell a story through pictures. The boys listened with rapt attention as he described character development from the imagination

through the drawing stage. He introduced the concept of a site visit to get a true read on the look and feel of the setting of the story. Mr. Ford walked the boys through a step-by-step illustration of their choice, Frankenstein, which now hangs proudly on the wall at Washington View to remind them of the visit. Thanks to the J. Willard and Alice S. Marriott Foundation, each student received their own copy of *Desmond and the Very Mean World*, signed by Mr. Ford.

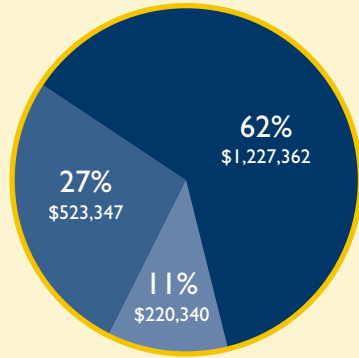

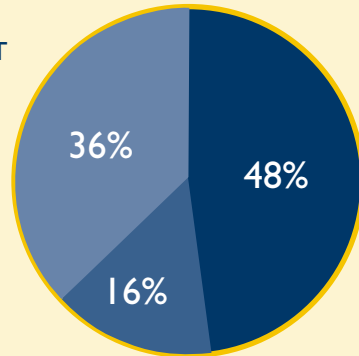

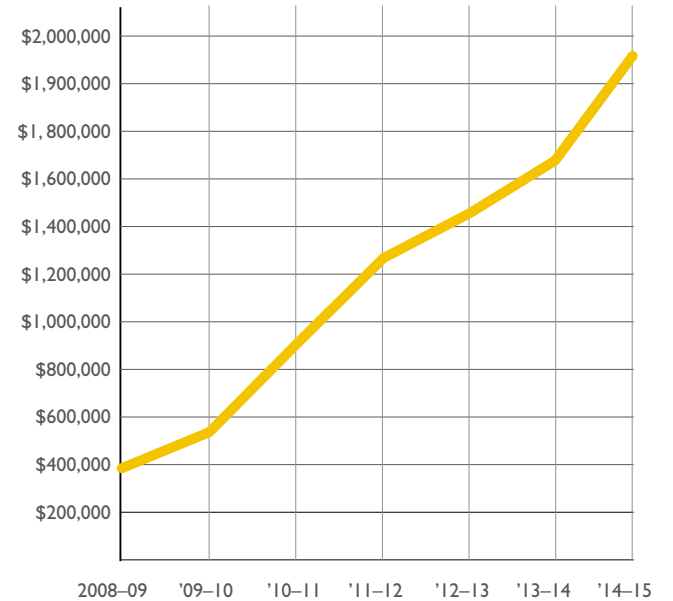

THE BISHOP WALKER SCHOOL (BWS) had a terrific seventh year. In the 2014–15 school year, our faculty inspired personal achievement in 81 boys from grades Junior Kindergarten through Fifth grade. We became an award winning school when our mission-focused work drew the attention of the Coalition of Schools Educating Boys of Color (COSEBOC). They honored BWS with their 2015 School Award for Excellence in Educating Boys of Color. This annual award recognizes and rewards three schools nationally who are successfully educating preK–12 male students of color. COSEBOC selects schools that can serve as models of promising practices and exhibit educational methods proven effective with male students of color. The award is given after a highly-selective and competitive process. As part of the awards process, BWS representatives were invited to Memphis to share our “secret sauce” with an audience of educators and practitioners from around the country. I am delighted to be affiliated with an organization which is so successfully living out its mission and helping our students realize their dreams and forge a bright future for themselves and their families.

Our 2014–15 academic testing results for Literacy and Math were but one measure of success for which COSEBOC recognized BWS:

82% of our students were at or above expectation in Literacy
74% of our students were at or above expectation in Math

The dedicated support of our generous donors, student sponsors and board members make these and our other achievements possible. We could not open our bright and well-appointed classrooms staffed by talented and experienced teachers to our students every day without your support. Neither could we ensure good nutrition, health and dental screenings, and safe, fun, and enriching morning care and afterschool programs that nurture the limitless potential of our students. Part of the “secret sauce” at BWS is that we celebrate each boy as his own inimitable self.

Because of your belief in our school and our students, we were able to achieve and surpass our fundraising goal of \$1,957,830, by raising \$1,971,049. The following pages recognize and honor all who demonstrated their belief in our mission by contributing their time, talent, and treasure to help our students succeed.

Over the past 6 years, donations have increased fourfold from \$397,253 in FY 2008 to \$1,971,049 in FY 2015 while the number of donors increased 81% from 516 to 936 during that same time period. The success of our boys is contagious, and we are seeing the results here at BWS. I look forward to this energy carrying us to a completed Middle School and our first class of graduates in 2018.

The Board and I are incredibly grateful for your support. We hope that you will continue to shine your goodwill and generous spirit on BWS and our students.

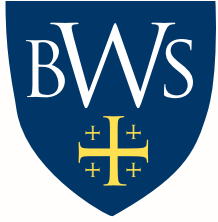
